

Online Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which the Los Angeles Police Relief Association ("LAPRA"), "we," "our," or "us") collects, uses, maintains, and discloses information collected from users (each, a "User") of our website ("Site").

Personal Identification Information

We may collect personal identification information from Users in various ways, including when Users visit our Site, fill out a form, or engage in other activities, services, features, or resources we offer on our Site. Depending on the interaction, Users may be asked for their name, email address, mailing address, phone number, and other relevant information. Users may also visit our Site anonymously, and we will only collect personal identification information if Users voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can choose not to provide personally identifiable information, but this may limit their ability to access certain Site-related activities.

Non-Personal Identification Information

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. This may include browser information, computer type, and technical details about Users' means of connecting to our Site, such as the operating system and internet service providers used, along with similar information.

Web Browser Cookies

Our Site may use "cookies" to enhance the User experience. Users' web browsers place cookies on their hard drives for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. Users may choose to set their web browsers to refuse cookies or to alert them when cookies are being sent. However, please note that some parts of the Site may not function properly if cookies are disabled.

How We Use Collected Information

LAPRA may collect and use Users' personal information for the following purposes:

- To operate and maintain our Site, ensuring content is displayed correctly.
- To improve our Site, we may use feedback provided by Users to enhance our products and services.

- To respond to inquiries, questions, and requests via email addresses or cellular telephone numbers provided.
- To send updates to job applicants regarding the status of their application with LAPRA and/or to schedule and follow up on interviews.
- To send periodic emails and texts, including surveys, updates, and relevant political and public policy information.
- To inform political and public policies by using survey responses collected.

How We Protect Your Information

We employ appropriate data collection, storage, and processing practices, as well as security measures, to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of personal information, transaction data, and any other data stored on our Site.

Sharing Your Personal Information

We will not share text messaging originator opt-in data and consent with any third parties unless required by law.

Third-Party Websites

Users may encounter advertising or other content on our Site that links to the sites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors, and other third parties. We do not control the content or links on these sites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Site. These external sites or services may have their own privacy policies and customer service policies. Browsing and interacting with any other website, including those linked to our Site, is subject to that website's own terms and policies.

LAPRA reserves the right to update this privacy policy at any time. When changes are made, they will be posted in our online Privacy Policy.
