2026 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Los Angeles Relief and Assistance Foundation (LAPRAF)
offers seven \$10,000 scholarships to graduating high school seniors.

The scholarships will be distributed at a rate of \$2,500 per school year over the next four years.

Eligibility Requirements

- Students must be high school seniors at the time they apply. Applications and the student's most recently available school transcript must be submitted no later than May 15, 2026.
- Students must have achieved at least a 2.5 GPA in high school.
- Students must have a parent or a legal guardian who is a member of the Los Angeles Police Relief Association (LAPRA).

Continuing Eligibility Requirements

- Students must maintain full-time student status at an accredited college or university (9 units or more) and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA.
- Proof of continued full-time student status and GPA will be required at the beginning of each school year. The necessary information shall be submitted to the LAPRA office prior to the beginning of each school year.
- Students' scholarship funding will permanently cease if they
 - Drop out of college unless it is for a valid emergency (valid emergencies shall be determined by the scholarship committee) or for entry into the United States military forces.
 - Are arrested and convicted of a felony.
